

Subdivision Act Workshop

Peter Lucas is conducting this workshop which will examine the procedural requirements of the Subdivision Act, looking at particular areas that are of relevance to local government.

Participants will be taken through the processes that are required to certify plans, to remove and vary easements and covenants, public open space requirements and the difficulties sometimes encountered for section 24A plans (vesting and removal of 'reserve land'). The workshop will be of particular relevance to property, subdivision and planning officers.

- statements of compliance;
- the effect of registration;
- compulsory acquisition and removal of easements;
- obtaining owner consents;
- public works;
- works agreements (including section 173 agreements);
- section 24A (reserve plans);
- appeals;
- role of referral authorities;
- open space requirements;
- easements and restrictions;
- section 35 plans; and
- case studies.
